ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION



Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that the Nevada State Board of Nursing suspended the license of Elizabeth Jane Kelly, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the State of Nevada. CASE NO. 1139-16CE

On Thursday, March 23, 2017, a hearing was held in the above matter before the Nevada State Board of Nursing ("Board") at the Hilton Garden Inn, Reno, 9920 Double R Boulevard, Reno, NV 89521 in compliance with the provisions of Chapters 233B and 632 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Chapter 632 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

Respondent Elizabeth Kelly did not appear at the hearing. The Nevada State Board of Nursing staff appeared through counsel, Kimberly A. Arguello, Esq.

Based upon NAC 632.923, the Board proceeded to consider the case without the participation of Respondent. Documents were admitted into evidence. Pursuant to NAC 632.923, the Board considered the charges specified in the Complaint to be true. Accordingly, the Board made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board, based upon NAC 632.923 and other evidence presented during the Hearing, finds that there is a preponderance of evidence in the record to establish each of the following findings of fact:

1. At least twenty-one (21) working days prior to the date of the hearing, Respondent had been noticed of the hearing by certified mail and by first class mail, which notice was mailed to Respondent's last known residential address.

2. The Board found that proper notice of the hearing was given to Respondent.

3. The Board had jurisdiction over the matter, and the Board could proceed to make a determination in the matter.

4. On August 17, 2010, Respondent was granted a permanent Licensed Professional Nurse (RN) license in the State of Nevada.

5. On September 12, 2016, Respondent submitted an application for renewal of her RN license. On that renewal application, Respondent attested she had completed thirty hours of Board-approved, nursing-related continuing education during the two-year renewal period. At least four hours of the continuing education must have been on bioterrorism, which is a one-time requirement mandated in Nevada.

6. On October 14, 2016, Respondent was randomly selected for a continuing education and bioterrorism audit. On that same day, Respondent was mailed a letter requested that she provide documentation in support of her attestation that she had completed the required continuing education to the Board.

7. As of this date, Respondent has failed to submit evidence of any continuing education.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the above Findings of Fact, the Board hereby finds by a preponderance of the evidence the following violation of law:

8. Respondent violated NRS 632.320(1)(g) unprofessional conduct, because Respondent violated NAC 632.415, and NAC 632.890(26) when Respondent failed to abide by any state or federal statute or regulation relating to the practice of nursing.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to NRS 632.347 and/or NAC 632.926,
Respondent Kelly's Nevada Licensed Practical Nurse License No. RN66396 is reprimanded.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's Nevada Professional Nurse's License
2 No. RN66396 be fined in the amount of two hundred dollars. Respondent shall submit payment
3 of the fine within thirty days of the effective date of this Order.
4

5 If Respondent fails to submit evidence of completion of the required courses and
6 payment of the fine to the Board within thirty days of the effective date of this Order,
7 Respondent's Nevada Professional Nurse's License No. RN66396 shall be suspended without
8 further proceedings until such time that Respondent completes the required courses and submits
9 payment of the fine.
10

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the reprimand shall become part of Respondent's
12 permanent record, be published on the Board's list of disciplinary actions, and be reported to the
13 appropriate data banks.

14 This Order shall become effective on 20th of May 2017.


