CONSENT ORDER

---

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Shanita Cynthia Robinson, R.M.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Robinson's registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Shanita Cynthia Robinson, R.M.A., was issued Registration Number 0031-004617 to practice as a medication aide on November 23, 2010, which is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2017.
2. Ms. Robinson violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(5) in that during the course of her employment with Carrington Place, Chesapeake, Virginia, on April 17, 2016, she attempted to transfer a resident from bed to chair by herself using a mechanical lift and using the wrong lift pad. The resident was obese and required two people to assist her in transferring with the mechanical lift. Ms. Robinson told the resident to hold on while transferring her; the resident let go and fell backwards, striking her head. The resident suffered a hematoma to the back of her head.
3. As a result of this incident, Ms. Robinson was suspended and received retraining on transferring residents. Her employment with Carrington Place was terminated in May 2016 for a different reason.

## CONSENT

Shanita Cynthia Robinson, R.M.A., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my registration except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Shanita Cynthia Robinson, R.M.A., is REPRIMANDED.
2. Shanita Cynthia Robinson, R.M.A., shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of registered medication aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

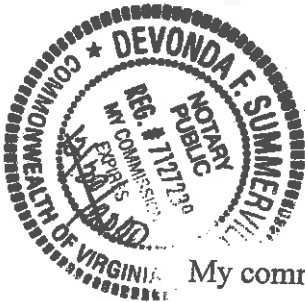
