CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and David Stuart George, R.M.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. George's registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. David Stuart George, R.M.A. was issued Registration Number 0031-001143 to practice as a medication aide on November 13, 2008, which is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2017.
2. Mr. George violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (8) and 18 VAC 90-60-110(A)(2) and 18 VAC 90-60-120(2)(l) and (m) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides in that during the course of his ownership of and employment with Aables Assisted Living, Cumberland, Virginia, between August 25 and September 11, 2015, after a resident's Risperdal (risperidone) had been discontinued by her physician, Mr. George continued to administer Risperdal to the resident, along with the resident's newly prescribed Invega (paliperidone).
3. The resident complained about being tired after taking both medications. There was no long-term harm to the resident noted.

CONSENT

David Stuart George, R.M.A., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my registration except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.


ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. David Stuart George, R.M.A., is REPRIMANDED.
2. David Stuart George, R.M.A. shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of registered medication aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
