Dear Mr. Anderson:

This is official notification that an informal conference will be held pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), **on August 4, 2014, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the Department of Health Professions, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233. You may be represented by an attorney at the conference. This informal conference will be convened as a public meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3700 *et seq.* of the Code.

The Special Conference Committee ("Committee"), which is comprised of at least two members of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), will receive and act upon your petition for release from probation and will inquire into allegations that you may be in violation of an Order of the Board entered August 1, 2011 ("Board's Order").

Specifically:

1. You may have violated Term No. 6 of the Board's Order, which required you to abstain from the use of alcohol or any other mood altering chemical except as prescribed and to submit written reports of any prescribed Schedule II-V medication within ten days of the date the medication is prescribed, in that:
  - a. On or about July 25, 2013, you tested positive for butalbital (Schedule VI) for which you did not have a valid prescription.
  - b. You failed to submit prescription reports in a timely manner.

2. You may have violated Term No. 7 of the Board's Order, which required you to undergo two supervised, unannounced, random drug screens a month, in that drug screens conducted by your employer at I and O Center, between May 2012 and February 2013, were not random and not all of the screens included alcohol.

After the informal conference, the Committee is authorized by § 54.1-2400(10) of the Code to take any of the following actions:

- The Committee may grant your petition for release from probation;
- The Committee may deny your petition for release from probation;
- The Committee may reprimand you;
- The Committee may modify a previous order; or
- The Committee may impose a monetary penalty.

Further, the Committee may refer the case to the Board of Nursing or a panel thereof for a formal hearing. If the Committee is of the opinion that suspension or revocation may be justified, the Committee may offer you a Consent Order for suspension or revocation in lieu of a formal hearing.


If you fail to appear at the informal conference, the Committee may proceed to hear the case in your absence and may take any of the actions outlined above. At least ten days prior to the scheduled date of the conference, please inform this office at (804) 367-4515, or in writing at the address listed above, of your telephone number and whether you intend to appear at the informal conference.

To facilitate this proceeding, you should submit five copies of any documents you wish the Committee to consider to the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, by July 28, 2014. Your documents may not be submitted by facsimile or email.

You have the right to the information on which the Board will rely in making its decision. Therefore, I have enclosed a copy of the documents that will be distributed to the members of the Committee and will be considered by the Committee when discussing any allegations with you and when deliberating on your case. **These documents are enclosed only with the original notice sent by certified mail, which you may be required to claim at the post office. Please bring these documents with you to the informal conference.**
