Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered January 23, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board of Nursing present at the hearing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your certificate, contact Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4639.

COMMONWEALTH'S EXHIBIT

Whereupon the defendant waived arraignment and the Court having been advised by the defendant, his counsel and the attorney for the Commonwealth that there has been a PLEA AGREEMENT in this case, and such agreement in writing having been presented to the Court, and now filed herein, and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, the Court accepts said agreement and the plea of guilty to INDICTMENT 1-FALSE STATEMENT TO GAIN ASSISTANCE-MEDICAID FRAUD, that the defendant tendered in person and finds the defendant guilty of same.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 2 YEARS for FALSE STATEMENT TO GAIN ASSISTANCE-MEDICAID FRAUD. The total sentence imposed is 2 YEARS.

This sentence shall run consecutively with all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS 1 YEAR 11 MONTHS AND 28 DAYS of the 2 YEAR sentence, for a period of 5 YEARS OR UNTIL RESTITUTION IS PAID IN FULL, for a total suspension of 1 YEAR 11 MONTHS AND 28 DAYS, upon the following condition(s): DEFENDANT IS ORDERED TO PAY \$2,650.50 IN RESTITUTION TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on his release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for an indeterminate period, until released by the Court or the Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer.

Unsupervised probation. The defendant shall be of uniform good behavior while in custody and for 5 YEARS OR UNTIL RESTITUTION IS PAID IN FULL after release from all confinement.

Fines/Costs/Restitution. The following amounts are due and payable within 15 days of the sentencing date. If the total payment is not made within 15 days of sentencing, you must enter into an Installment Agreement Plan with the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and a judgment entered therein. All payments are to be made payable to the Clerk, Norfolk Circuit Court.

Credit for time served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code Section 53.1-187.

The Court, by motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth, Orders a Nolle Prosequi be entered with regard to INDICTMENTS 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 AND 9, and the defendant discharged thereon.
