CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Brenda Archinal, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Archinal's license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Brenda Archinal, L.P.N. was issued License No. 0002-027197 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on September 7, 1979. Said license is set to expire on September 30, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. During the course of her employment with Franklin Health and Rehab, Rocky Mount, Virginia, on or about February 14 and 15, 2013:
 - a. Ms. Archinal failed to recognize a transcription error, committed by another nurse, and not recognized or corrected by pharmacy staff, related to the administration frequency of an anticoagulant to Resident A;
 - b. Ms. Archinal failed to immediately notify Resident A's physician that she had withheld a dose of the anticoagulant medication after a CNA observed a spot of blood on a tissue in the resident's mouth at approximately 2:00 a.m. Ms. Archinal did immediately check the resident's mouth and did not note any further bleeding at that time. Shortly thereafter, at approximately 3:20 am, Ms. Archinal noted a few spots of blood in the resident's mouth and immediately notified the physician.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Findings of Fact Nos. 2(a) and 2(b) constitute violations of § 54.1-3007(2), (5), and (8) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(f) of the Regulations

Governing the Practice of Nursing.

CONSENT

Brenda Archinal, R.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of her counsel, Michael Goodman , Esquire and Eileen Talamante, Esquire, prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, §2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She neither admits nor denies the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Brenda Archinal is hereby REPRIMANDED.
2. Ms. Archinal shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made

available for public inspection or copying upon request.

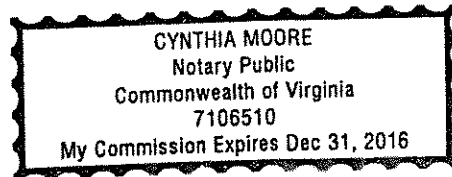
